SLACK



Slack is one of the most popular remote work tools for a reason. Slack stands for "searchable log of all conversation and knowledge" and serves as a messaging tool thoughtfully organized into smaller teams and subject channels. It's a great way to reduce email load and stay organized within a large team. Best of all, it creates searchable records of group conversations!

VOODLE

Voodle is a video platform that allows you to record short video messages (up to 60 seconds) to share with your team. Voodle is a great way to communicate asynchronously while maintaining an authentic human feel and can help to reduce typing time as well as the dreaded Zoom burnout. Use it for company updates, brainstorming, or as a cultural connection point for a remote team.

HUBSPOT



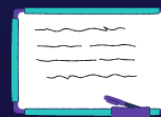

WURKR
